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Summit Healthcare Day @HIMSS to Feature HIMSS' New Cybersecurity Hub

Interactive Experience to Immerse Healthcare IT Pros

(CLEVELAND) — The 14th annual Security Summit Week's (SSW) Healthcare Day will feature the new HIMSS' Cybersecurity Hub where healthcare IT professionals will be able to experience an interactive approach to help them prepare their organizations to defend against cyber attacks and adversaries. One of the highlights of the week-long SSW event, Healthcare Day will be Wednesday, October 26, 2016 at the HIMSS Innovation Center at the Global Center for Healthcare Innovation in Cleveland.
