## Security Summit Week's Career Connection Links Students, Veterans, Job Seekers and Cybersecurity Pros

(CLEVELAND) — The 2016 Security Summit Week will offer students, veterans and IT job seekers who are seeking cybersecurity connections and career opportunities a one-of-a-kind opportunity to connect with leading area industry organizations and human resource recruiters and industry advisers at its Career Connection on Wednesday, October 26th at LaCentre in Westlake.
